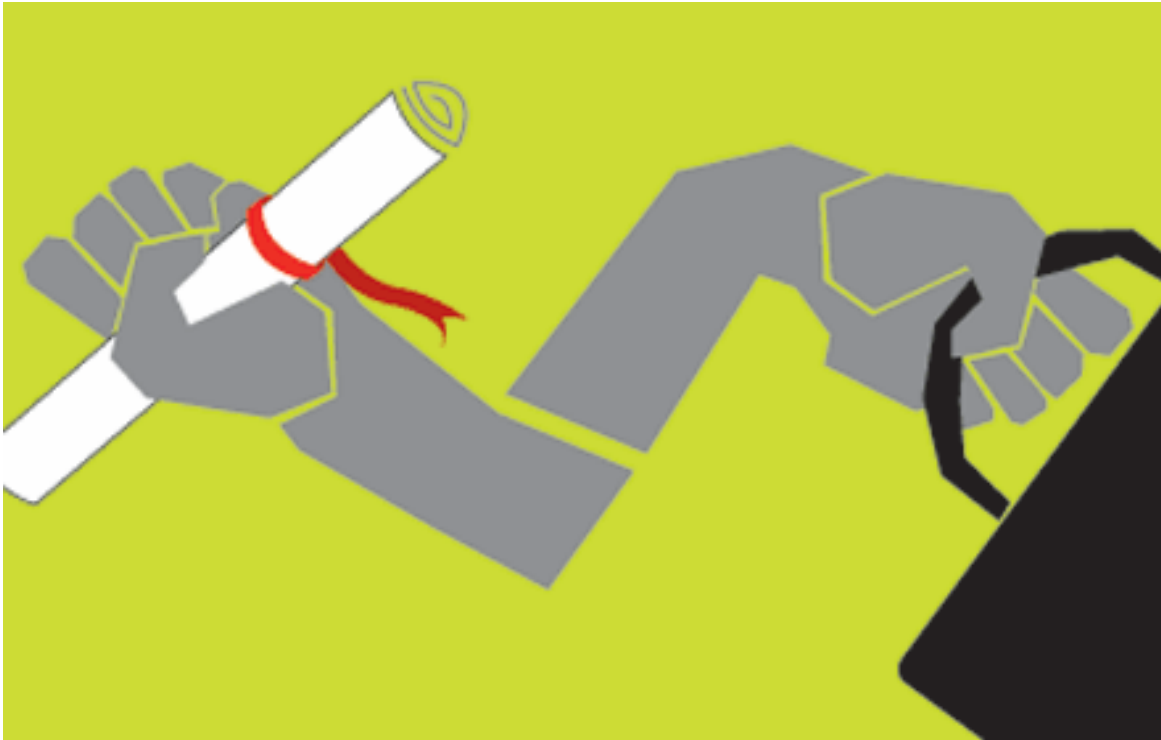


Professional Development I: Applying for Positions

This two-unit course is designed to make graduate students in the Humanities familiar with the process of seeking an academic position. It guides students through every step of job-hunting, from assembling a dossier and writing application letters to the interview and the campus visit. The topics are structured so that each step is discussed while students are actually engaged in it; for example, they produce a *curriculum vitae* and an application letter that they will use in their actual job applications. The course meets for two-hour sessions every other week and is designed for students who will be applying for positions for the first time in fall 2007, or who expect to do so the following year.
